Beth El Turns 100!

In honor of Beth El's Centennial celebration, here are some fun facts and tidbits from our history:

On October 3, 1920, a meeting was held in Benjamin Natal's law office to organize a new congregation in Camden. On October 17, 1920, South Jersey's first Conservative congregation was "organized" and elected Morris Handle as Beth El's first president.

Beth El Sisterhood was founded on November 1, 1921. By the fall of 1935, Sisterhood had 200 members and annual dues were \$2.

Beth El Men's Club was organized in 1937. The Men's Club sponsored the Blood Bank drive dating back to 1957 with a goal of collecting 125 pints.



Rabbi Harry B. Kellman was installed as Beth El's Rabbi on September 9, 1947 by Dr. Max Artz. Louis L. Goldman was the chairman of the installation ceremonies.

The USY (United Synagogue Youth) group was founded in 1953.

In the fall of 1958, Beth El started an all day kindergarten called "The Foundation School" under the supervision of Dr. Samuel Rosenblum.

The Young Associates group was organized during the summer of 1960. The group had 115 founding members and M. Zev Rose was the first president serving for 2 years.

The Golden Jubilee Committee in 1970 included Lois Asbell and Shirley Yaffa.

If I Knew Then...

If I was told twenty years ago, as a new Educational Director at the Society for the Advancement of Judaism in NYC, the flagship synagogue of the Reconstructionist Movement, that in the year 2020 a pandemic would hit and all of our

educational programs would be remote and online, I would have thought it was a joke. In fact, I would probably not have understood what virtual or remote meant, as the internet was not as sophisticated then as it is today.

However, almost a year ago, the world as we knew it literally changed overnight. In person traditional education as we knew it, turned upside down. A whole new age of learning has been introduced and I am so proud of what we here at Congregation Beth El have achieved these past 7 months.

After months of learning, evaluating, and researching, we at Beth El, have created inspiring, meaningful, and spiritual learning opportunities for learners of all ages. Although our physical building may not be fully



open, our educational programming is stronger than ever. Not only have we adapted to our new "normal", we have surpassed our expectations! Our new and innovative programming has

been more accessible and has brought Judaism into so many lives of our congregation.

One of our new programs created as an outcome of the pandemic is our new Teen Summit Program. This year I am thrilled to announce that our S.A.I.L Hebrew High School, together with Temple Beth Sholom's Hebrew High School received a grant from the JCF Community Endowment Fund for our new Teen Summit Program. This new initiative was created to bring the Jewish teens together virtually during these isolating times. Six times a year (three Tuesdays and three Thursdays) our teens will gather through Zoom to learn and socialize together. Each session features a well-known speaker. Our first Summit took place on October 13 and featured former Knicks player Michael Sweetney. Michael Sweetney was an all American Georgetown player, a lottery pick for the New York




Knicks and is the assistant Basketball Coach for Yeshiva University and basketball coordinator of Camp Ramah Poconos. Michael shared an inspirational talk and answered questions about his life in the NBA, struggling with Mental Illness, and Justice and health in today's world. Our next Teen Summit will take place on November 19 with guest speaker Ariana Berlin, an American artistic gymnast, dancer and film actress who competed for the UCLA Bruins gymnastics team, and is currently a producer for Fox. Ariana will share her story and her ties to Judaism. For more information to join these teen summits please email me at nmarshall@bethelsnj.org.




So, yes, if I knew 20 years ago I would have to transform our educational programs from traditional learning to virtual learning, I would have embraced this challenge. And that is what we have done here at Beth El. We embraced the challenge and dreamed big. And I will continue to work with my incredible team of teachers, educators, and committees to provide the most innovative, creative, educational, meaningful, and spiritual programs possible for all of our students.

A BETH EL 100 MESSAGE FROM THE ECC

100 years. 100 years of being a spiritual home. 100 years of being a community. 100 years of education, experiences, celebrations and so much more. Beth El turning 100 is something worth celebrating, even to a "newbie" like me.

I am relatively new to Beth El having only been involved for about 5 years; first as a parent in the ECC and then as part of our incredible Beth El team. In my short time with Beth El, I have come to think of it as my home. The Clergy, Staff and Congregants are my family. The services, events, and educational experiences, are simply the cherry on top.

Some of you may know this story, and some of you may not, but I'd like to share with you what drew me to Beth El. For that, we need to go back 27 years, to when I was 16 years old, and went on the March of the Living. For those of you who do not know, the March of the Living is a journey from dark to light, that takes you through the devastation of the concentration camps in Poland, then to Israel, to see how the Jewish people have thrived, even in the face of such horror.

The experience raised many questions for me. I lost faith in humanity to a certain extent, and also lost my faith in Gd. I turned to my Rabbi for guidance, and support. I wanted to believe that my faith could and would be restored, but unfortunately I was given very little comfort or reassurance.

I can honestly say that over the years, my faith in my religion waned. I didn't have a community that I felt connected to, having moved so many times. My faith took a back burner in my life.

That all changed, as soon as I came to Beth El.

I had toured Beth El as I was looking for care for my then-toddler. During the tour, I was told how inclusive and welcoming the community was, and was then invited to join Beth El for Rosh Hashanah. No ticket, no membership packet with dues, just "JOIN US!" So, I did. I joined that Rosh Hashanah morning, with cautious optimism. What I experienced was an incredibly inspiring sermon by Rabbi Green. His sermon was full of love, and of the importance of forgiveness. After Rosh Hashanah, I joined again for Shabbat mornings and heard more beautiful sermons by Rabbi Krupnick.

These sermons reminded me how much my faith means to me. Joining for Shabbat, and being invited by a beautiful congregant to be part of her "Shabbat Family", was everything my soul had been missing. I had found my spiritual home. I was reminded that being a good Jew meant being able to forgive, to ask questions, to be tolerant, and to love with my whole heart. All of which are at the core of Beth El.

Joining Beth El, reminded me how important it is for me to keep Shabbat with my family, and say the *Shema* with Maya before bed every night. It reminded me how important it is for me to fight with all of my being to keep Judaism alive and well in my life and in the lives of my family. It reminded me how important it is for me to be a part of a community that preaches love, acceptance, hope, and generosity.

This is what why we celebrate Beth El. A synagogue that is so much more than just a spiritual home. A place that has meant so much to so many for so long; and yet has resonated so beautifully with someone like me in very recent years. Normally, when someone has a birthday, we say "*Ad me'ah v'esrim*", which translates to "May you live to be 120". In this case Beth El will meet that milestone before we know it. So, I'd like to wish Beth El, something different. I would like to wish Beth El "*Od me'ah v'esrim*", another 120 years! Another 120 years of love, innovative engagement, inclusion, growth, and beautiful spiritual meaning. May this place forever be for others, what it has been for me.

"In 1992 when Milton Sternberg was President of Beth El, he attended a three day conference with other synagogue presidents. He reported to the Board of Trustees all the new committees discussed, one being social action. I immediately volunteered to chair and with a small group we reached out to various places

in the community. Beth El was always dedicated to Federation and Jewish causes but did very little outside the Jewish community. We opened the door to Samaritan Hospice, Cooper outpatient pediatric facility, South Jersey aids coalition, Caring Hearts Ministries and many other agencies. We had a toy collection for Cooper pediatrics and, along with volunteers, we spent the day with Santa giving out the gifts. The Religious school made cards and Matzah covers to put in Passover bags for the Jewish patients under the care of Samaritan Hospice. 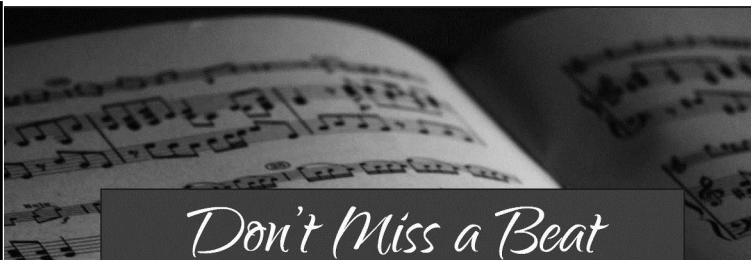

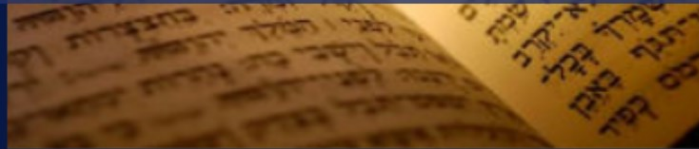
